On behalf of the Board of Directors and the entire Riverkeeper organization, thank you once again for your support of the 2006 Oyster Roast. Your contribution of \$400.00 for four tickets on November 13, 2006 contributed to the success of the event and our ability to continue our important advocacy work on behalf of the St. Johns River and its tributaries.

With your help, Riverkeeper was able to continue to make significant progress in 2006 toward our goal of a clean and healthy St. Johns River.


- ✓ This year, the proposed wetland impacts for the Freedom Commerce Centre have been reduced to less than 30 acres. This is a significant reduction from the original proposal of nearly 260 acres.
- ✓ Riverkeeper launched the successful River Friendly Yards public awareness campaign that included the television program *The Green Monster – It Came From The River*. *The Green Monster* was even nominated for three Emmy Awards.
- ✓ Riverkeeper successfully forced the Environmental Protection Agency to establish a meaningful nutrient pollution reduction program.

In 2007, Riverkeeper will release a Permit Compliance Report that documents permit violations and enforcement activities in the lower St. Johns River. We are working with St. John & Partners to continue to educate the public about establishing and maintaining a "river-friendly" yard. Once again, we will offer our 3-day Eco-Heritage Boat Trips in the fall and spring. The next boat trips will take place April 24 - 29, 2007.

As you know, St. Johns Riverkeeper is a 501c(3) non-profit organization. Your contribution is tax-deductible to the extent allowable by law. With your Oyster Roast donation, you received \$232 worth of goods and services, based on a good faith estimate of the market value as required by law.

Once again, we thank you for supporting the Oyster Roast and hope that we can count on your continued support in 2007!
